## **What is happening:**

A Scheduled match between TAS and The Wanderers Cricket Club.

## **Training:**

Training will take place at the National Cricket Centre, Allan Border Field, 20 Greg Chappell St, Albion. Training will begin at 4:00 and conclude at 6:00.

All selected players **and** shadow players should attend this session with arrival set for 4:00pm so that training can begin at 4:15.

## **Match Date:**

March 14 from 8:30am until 5:00pm.

## **Match process:**

- Players arrive, at the Ground, in formal school uniforms by **8.30 am**.
- Morning Tea is provided, from **8.30 am**, for Players, Parents & Officials.
- Presentation of the TAS Caps at **9.00 am** with official individual photographs.
- Official Team Photographs at **9.15 am** TAS team in College blazers and in whites.
- The Match (50 overs per side) commences at **9.30 am**.
- Lunch is taken at about **12.45 pm** – after the first **50 overs**.
- The Match will conclude around **5.00 pm**.
- There will be a **Presentation Ceremony**, after the Match.
- A photographer will be organised, by the Wanderers.

### **Player & Shadow Player Responsibilities:**

- All selected players are to inform the TAS Executive Officer or the team coach of their availability or otherwise for the match on March 14.
- All players selected to represent The Associated Schools must adhere to the Association's Code of Conduct at all times.
- Selected players must complete a '*consent to play*' form and hand it to TAS coaching/management staff at training or prior to the match taking place.
- **Shadow players** shall attend training and be prepared to play in the game *if/and only if they are called upon*. **Shadow players** do not need to attend game unless/until called upon to replace one of the selected players.
- Players are responsible for attending training sessions and matches as set out by the Association.

### **Attire:**

- Players should attend and leave the match in their formal school uniform (including blazers but hats are not required).
